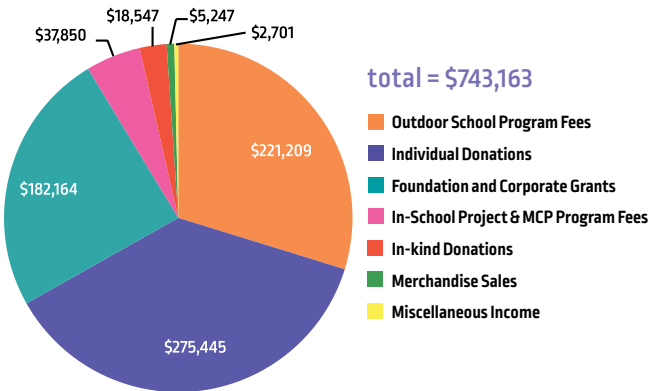

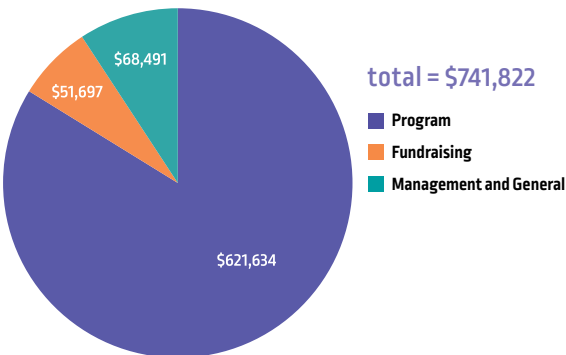
Since 2001, we have served:
