Mosaic was my **best childhood experience**. I made a promise to come back as a cabin leader when I turned 15. Now I'm here to **give back!**

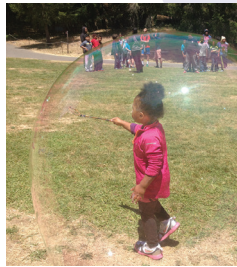

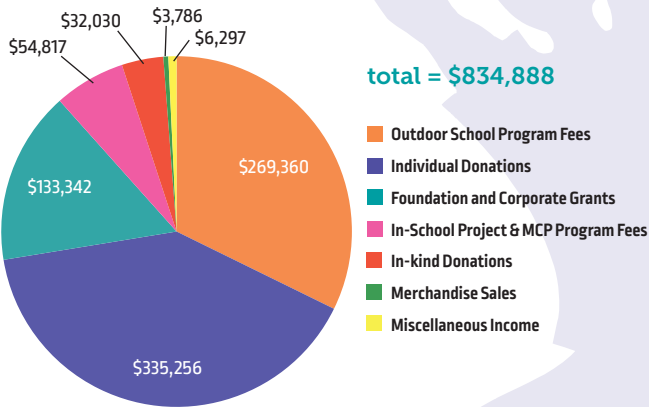

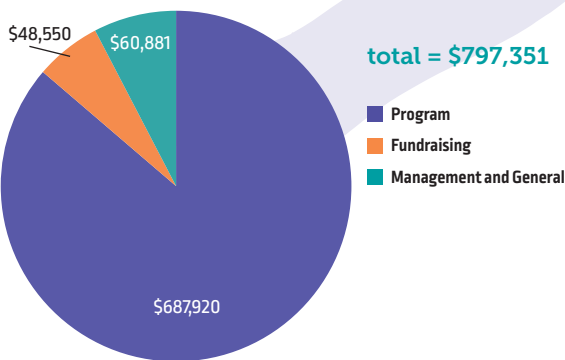
Since 2001, we have served:
