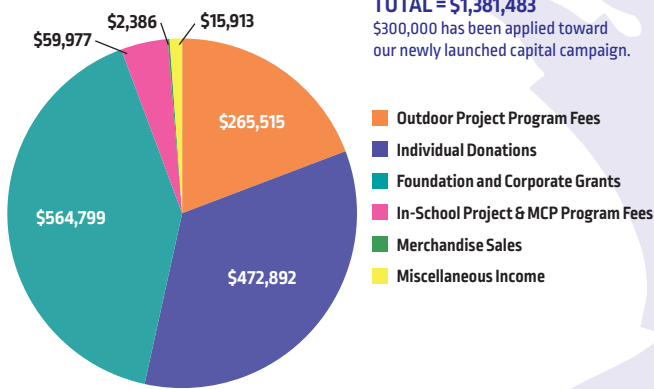

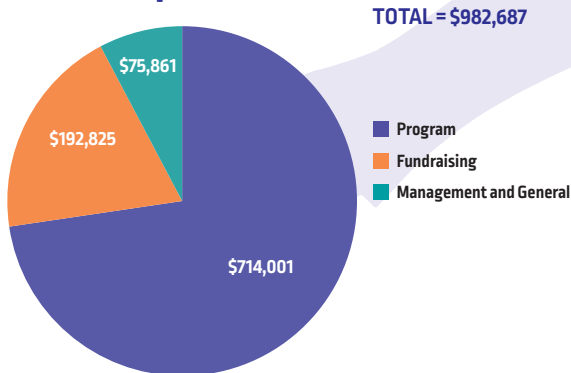
Since 2000, we have served more than 50,000 individuals.
